K-12 COVID-19 Contact Tracing

GENERAL RULES

Quarantine

Students are 6 feet or less for a total of 15 minutes or more in a 24-hour period with no mask.

Student is less than 3 feet from infected person, regardless of masks.

Student has direct exposure to respiratory secretions of someone with COVID-19 (e.g., being coughed or sneezed on)

No Quarantine

Student was within 3 – 6 feet of infected person but both were wearing masks properly.

Student is fully vaccinated and no symptoms are present.

(VDH requires student to monitor symptoms and wear a mask in indoor public settings for 14 days.)

Student tested positive with COVID-19 within the last 3 months and have no current symptoms.

- If student's exposure is from a positive household member, they must quarantine until positive person is released from isolation PLUS an additional 10 days because exposure is considered ongoing within the house. Student must continue to monitor symptoms for a total of 14 days.
- A person with COVID-19 is considered to be contagious starting from 2 days before they became sick (or 2 days before test specimen collection if they never had symptoms) until they meet the criteria to discontinue isolation.
